The study plan is divided into four levels, including eight semesters in addition to the semester

Summer courses, and the number of courses in each semester ranges between five and six courses, including:

So practical training. The percentage of courses taught in English exceeds 50% of the total.

Of the 47 academic courses (139 credit hours), there are two internship courses

And external, and five courses to provide students with basic skills in both Arabic and English
